STATEMENT FROM JIM KELLER ON THE ARREST OF CONGRESSIONAL  
CANDIDATE LYNDA LLAMAS

"I have just been shown some video footage of Lynda Llamas, my opponent from the Peace and Freedom Party, being arrested during a peaceful act of civil disobedience on Monday (March 20) outside the office of Senator Dianne Feinstein.

"While Lynda and I disagree on many issues, we stand united against the Iraq war. Unfortunately, I was not available to attend this protest myself. And although I would have chosen to obey the law if I had been there, I understand and support Lynda's choices. I deeply admire her courage and conviction to the cause.

"Senator Feinstein should be ashamed that this protest outside her office was even necessary, and should immediately start working toward a more sensible foreign policy."
